# NOTABLE RECENT VICTORIES

On March 14, all five candidates endorsed by the IRNA in the cities of Sebastian and Vero Beach won their elections.

All ran on a platform to moderate growth and in Sebastian restraint in annexation was an issue. Congratulations to Sabin Abell, Ken Daige and Tom White in Vero Beach and Sal Neglia and Al Paternoster in Sebastian and to our volunteers in this campaign, a most sincere thanks.

Three weeks later on April 4th, the County Commission voted to allow a referendum (more on our website [www.indianriverna.com](http://www.indianriverna.com)) concerning the Urban Service Line (USL). The November referendum will be a "straw ballot," meaning it is a nonbinding measure merely indicating the voters' feelings on the issue. The significance is that a YES vote on the referendum will get the attention of our County Commissioners and State Legislature and will be a positive step in achieving the IRNA objective of managing growth by maintaining the USL in its current location. We commend Chairman Neuberger, Commissioner Bowden and Vice Chairman Wheeler for their favorable vote on the referendum. We believe Commissioners Davis and Lowther are wrong to have voted against a referendum on this important issue, but the proof is now where it should be...in your hands and with your vote in November for the referendum and September 5 for our endorsed candidates for County Commissioner.
